

Hardy House

Hardy House is a former club building in the heart of a Wiltshire village. The existing conversion was inappropriate for the clients' needs whose brief called for the refurbishment of the existing house with the provision of new home working facilities for their artistic activities. The completed home features two study spaces, one for each of the two clients. The existing lounge space was transformed into a private gallery for the client to exhibit her own work. Comprehensive refurbishment of the existing house has created a clean, modern interior and offered improvements to reduce running costs and increase thermal performance.

A second phase of development takes advantage of the large garden with long views. A proposed new garden room will provide a tranquil living area and working space away from the busy street-front house, with a new landscaped courtyard created between the two elements.
